When you're putting fertilizer on the lawn,

remember you're not just putting it on the lawn.

Rain washes fertilizer into storm drains, which lead straight to our streams, local waterbodies, and the ocean.

BE WISER ABOUT FERTILIZER!

Fertilizer adds excessive nutrients to our waterways, causing overgrowth of algae, which uses up oxygen that fish need

Use fertilizers sparingly (or try compost instead!), and never fertilize before a rainstorm.
